

Rules for Pikes Peak 100 Anniversary Category

Appearance and safety equipment.

roll cage attached to vehicle

approved racing seats mounted to the structure with over the shoulder type shoulder harness

all closed cockpits must have a window net or glass with glass in passenger door windows

open cockpit vehicles must have arm restraints

fire systems are mandatory

must have headlights, backlights, and taillights

functioning windshield wipers are recommended

Ignition switch should be clearly labeled for on/off positions and be painted day glow orange

Master electrical cut-off switch is mandatory and be painted day glow orange and located in reach of emergency responders and driver while belted

Any shut-off switch must be clearly labeled for on/off and painted day glow orange

Numbers and decals on Vehicles

Limited to a maximum of 3 digits at least 12 scale inches high and must be displayed on:

both sides of car

hood or roof(or nose as applicable)

Refer to General Competition Rules, Part XIII for mandatory decals

Tires

DOT and Manufactured race tires are allowed

No more than 4 wheels and tires allowed
